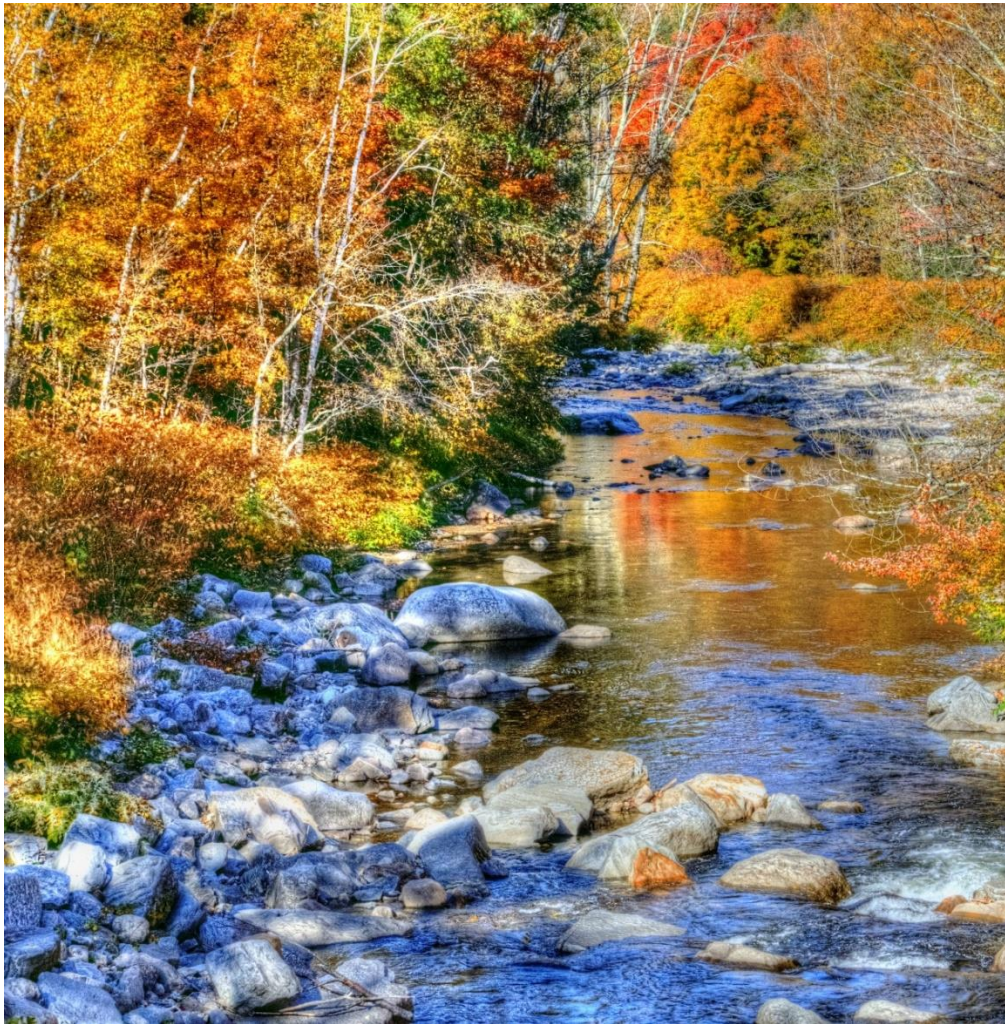

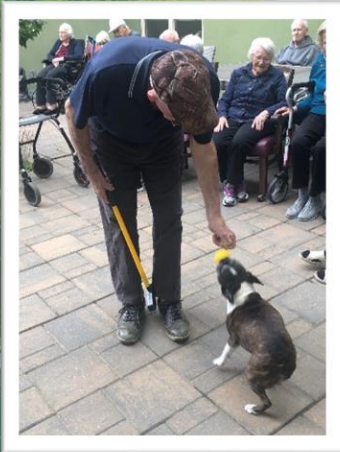
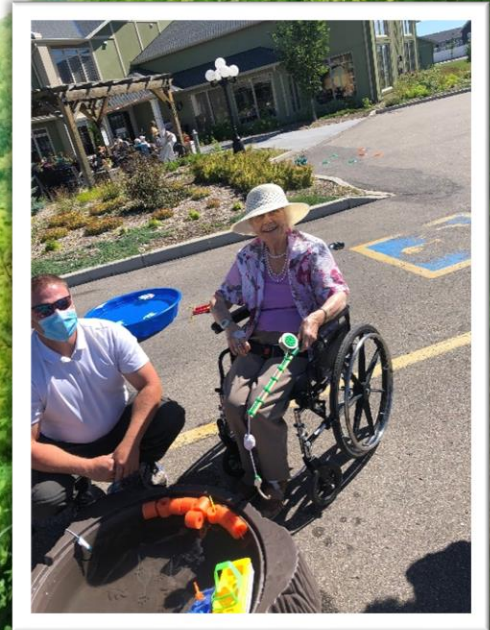

Wanuskewin Heritage Park Tour

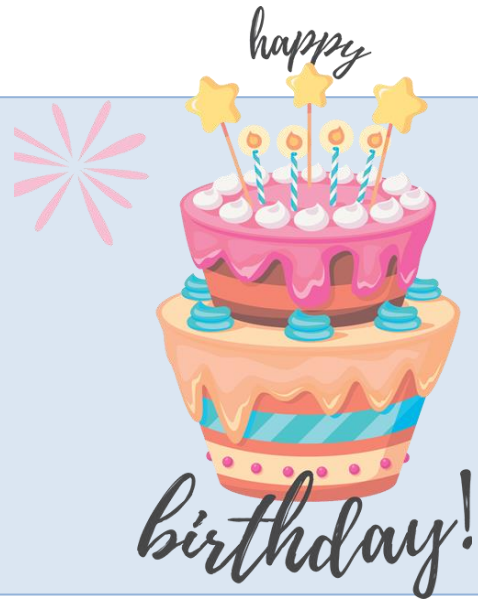

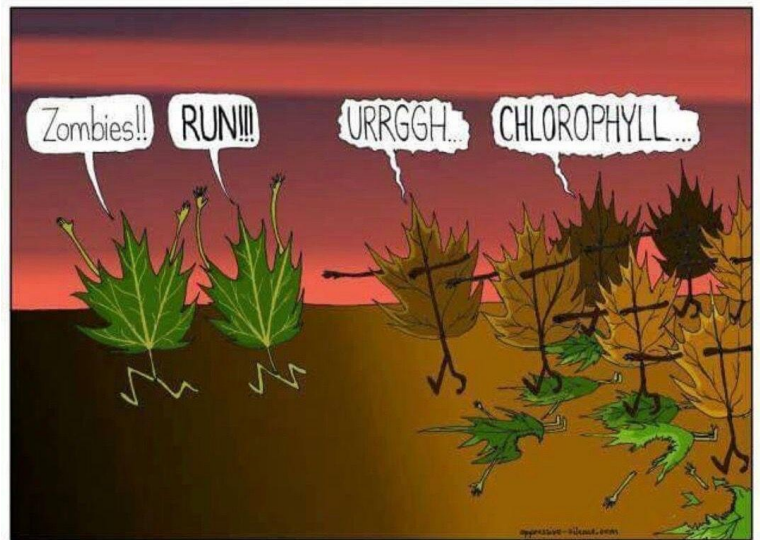

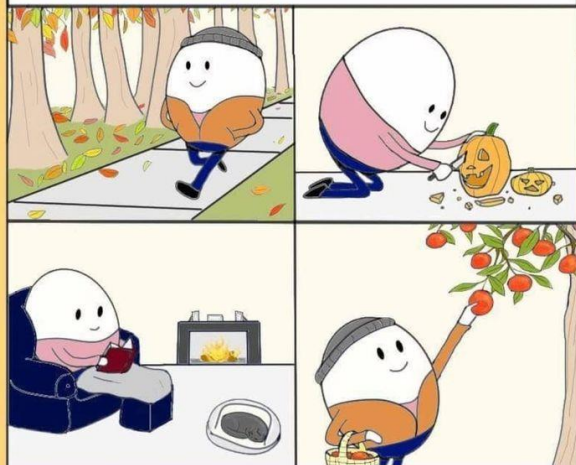

Smoked salmon and cream cheese dip

A classic appetiser that's perfect for any occasion.

Ingredients:

- One packet of cream cheese (250g or 8 ounces)
- One packet of Smoked salmon (pre-sliced is better)
- Dill
- Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tablespoon of chives

Method:

- Cut smoked salmon into small pieces
- Mash together salmon pieces with cream cheese either in food processor or with a fork
- Add 3 dashes of Worcestershire sauce and mix
- Pile a teaspoonful of dip onto a water cracker or toast and serve



Irish Coffee – Non-alcoholic, can be served hot or chilled.

Ingredients

- Brandy or Rum flavouring
- Sugar
- 1 ½ cups (12 ounces) of coffee
- Whipped cream



Directions

- Place 1 teaspoon of Brandy or Rum flavouring into a tall glass
- Pour 1 ½ cup coffee into the glass, leaving 1 inch at the top for cream
- Add 3 teaspoon sugar and stir
- Add whipped cream on top (do not stir)

Warm Apple Cider Drink

Ingredients

- 2 litres (½ gallon) of apple cider
- 1 orange
- 6 cloves
- A pinch of nutmeg
- 2 inch piece of ginger sliced
- 8 cinnamon sticks



Directions

- Peel zest from orange with vegetable peeler and cut into long strips
- Place all ingredients into a pot and warm on medium fire

Materials:

- Construction paper for sunflowers and leaves
- Coloured pencils or acrylic paint, in different shades of yellow, orange, red, and other warm colours
- Paint brushes
- Craft Glue
- Containers of water to clean brushes
- Paper towels to dab excess paint
- Large sheet of construction paper to mount the project



Instructions

- Ask a group of clients to draw sunflowers; any size; from very large to small. Clients may need some inspiration; get hold of some pictures of sunflowers from magazines and old calendars (or the internet) and put on display for encouragement.
- Paint sunflowers in different shades of yellow and orange.
- Cut them out.
- Assemble sunflowers on a poster.

Visitor Information

Visitors are now welcome into the home again. Visiting hours are Sunday-Saturday 9:30am-11:00pm

We do still require the following:

- + You must still sign in on the sheet provided at the Front Entrance **(This is for Fire Safety)**
 - When entering we need your name, contact phone number, and who you are visiting. (Resident name & house, Home administrator, Home Coordinator, Activity Department etc.)
- + You must change your mask to one of the medical masks that are provided.
- + You must sanitize your hands.
- + **When exiting the home after your visit, please sign out as well. This is just as important as signing in.**

Leaving with a loved one

There is a sign in/out form on the front entrance table that you need to fill out when leaving the home with a loved one, even if it is just to go for a walk around the block.

If leaving for a day trip: Please contact the home at least **an hour** before hand. This is so that we can have any medications or supplies ready that your loved one may need during their time away.

If leaving for more than a day: Please contact the home at **least 24hrs** in advance. This is so that we can have any medications or supplies ready that your loved one may need during their time away.
