




Ruth Allan (H4)


I'm not hard of hearing. I've just


He was predeceased by his wife Shirley, parents Pauline and Henry; and brothers Russell and Murray.


Well known for befriending people of all ages and walks of life, he loved a good story and enjoyed spending time with those closest to him.



And think of her as living in the hearts of those she touched... For nothing loved is ever lost and she was loved so much.




Ann & Jake Meyer (H4)


