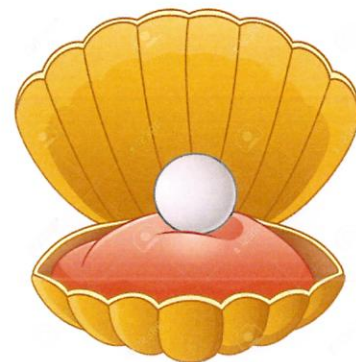
Henry is a Gemini. They are spontaneous, playful and adorably erratic, driven by an insatiable curiosity.

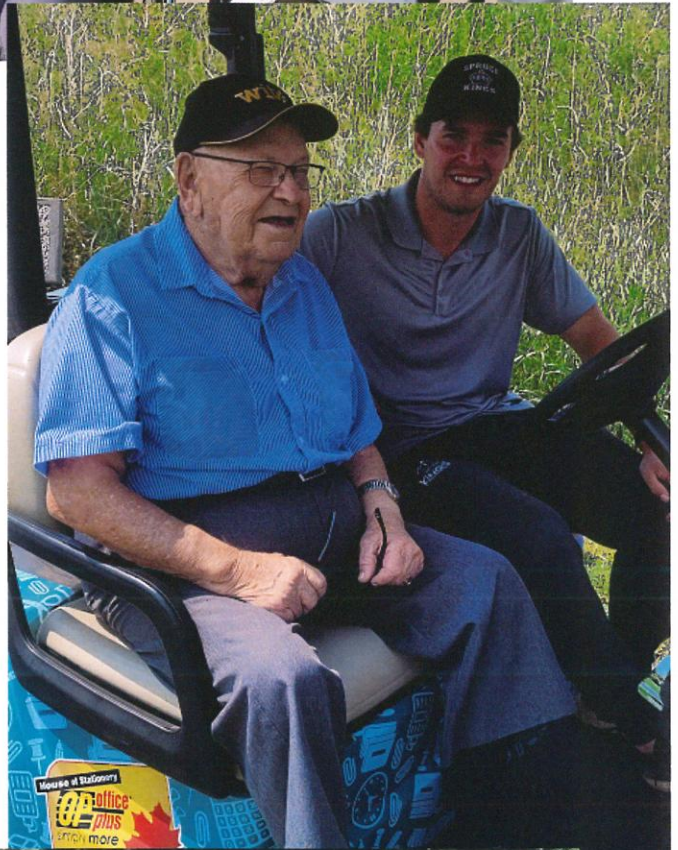
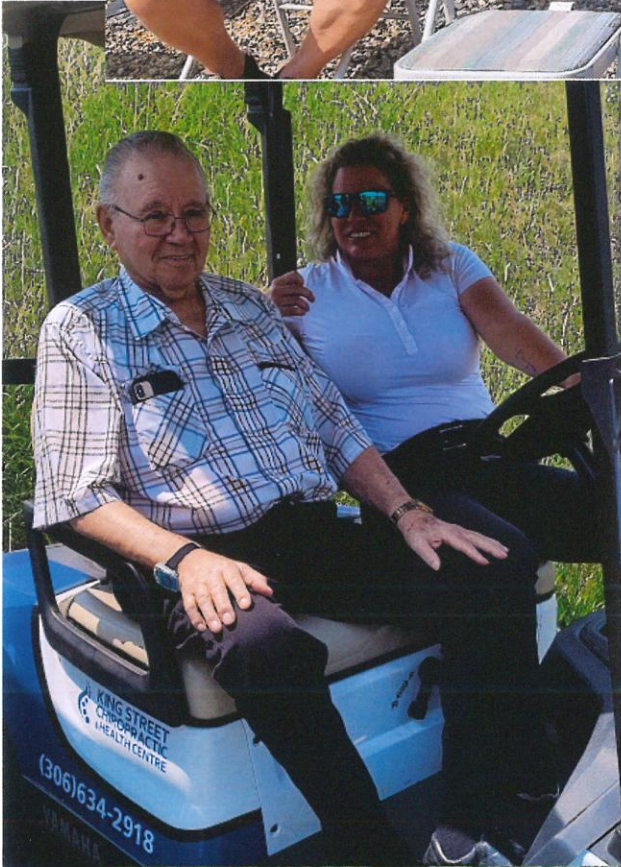

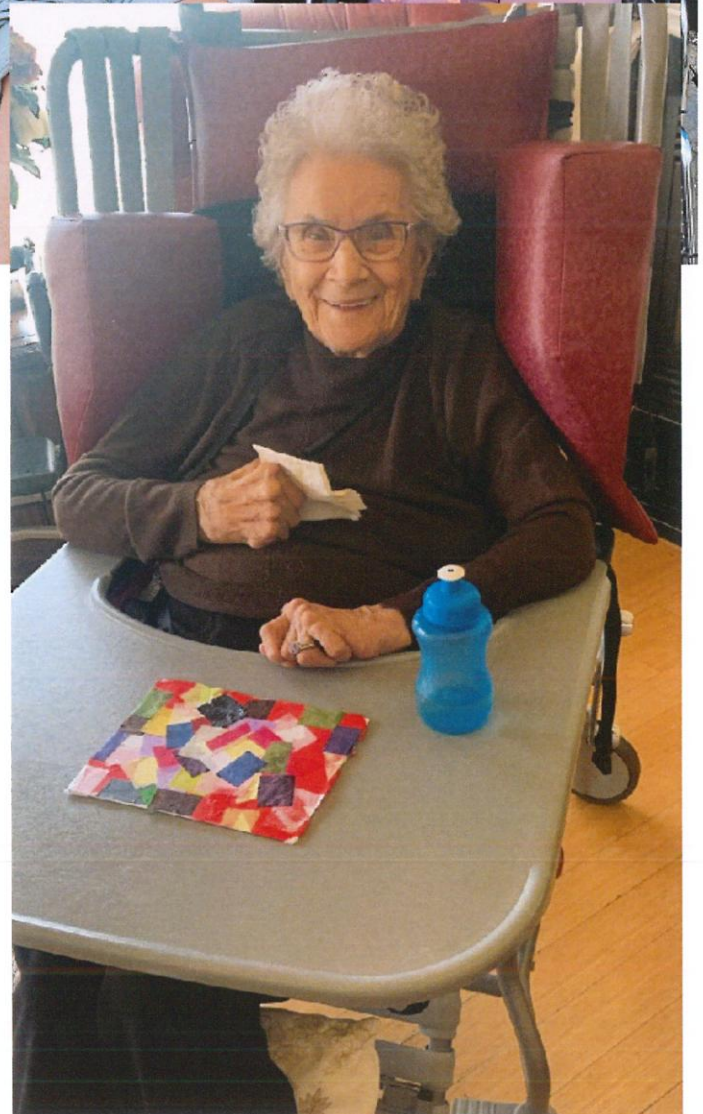
- Don't make me stop this car

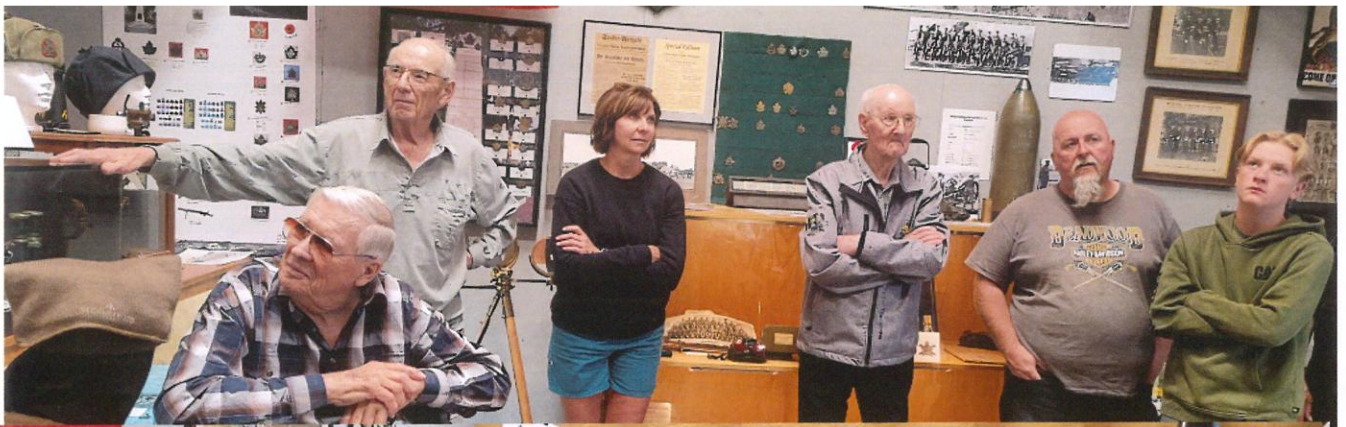


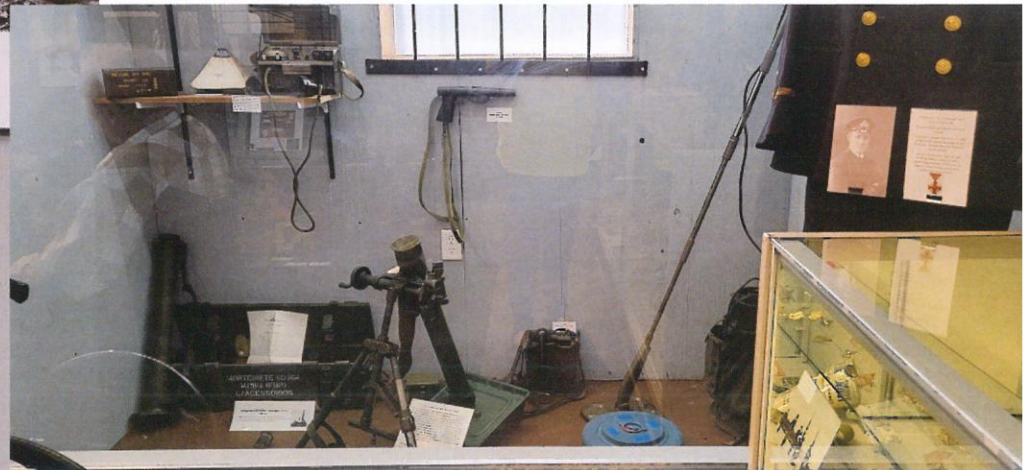


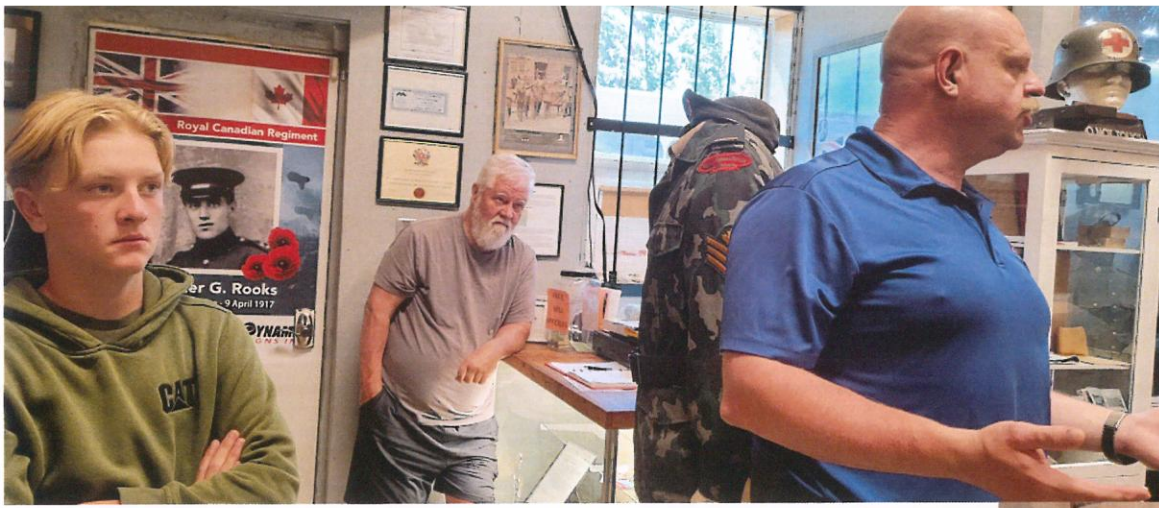






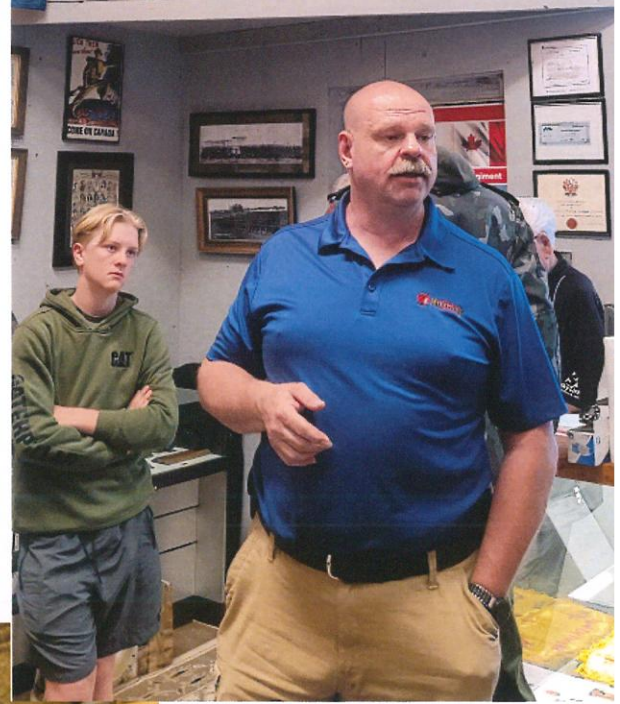
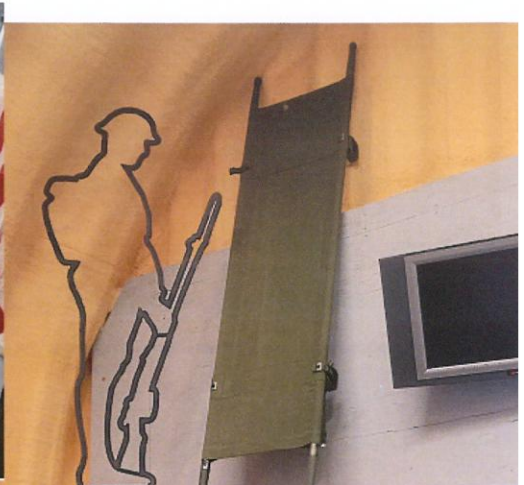






WW2 Canadian Summer Tunic

Cavalry Regiment - 14th Canadian Armoured Regiment




























