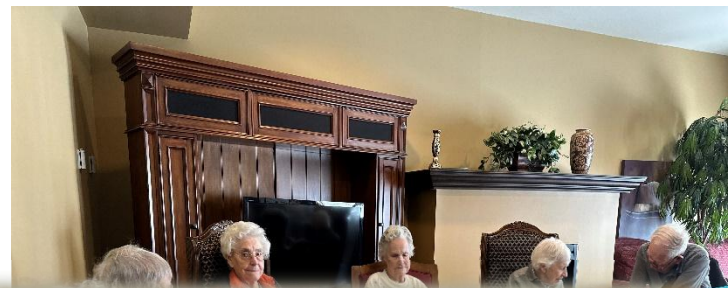
**Leonard Harms { Oct. 24, 1926- Jan. 14, 2023 }**

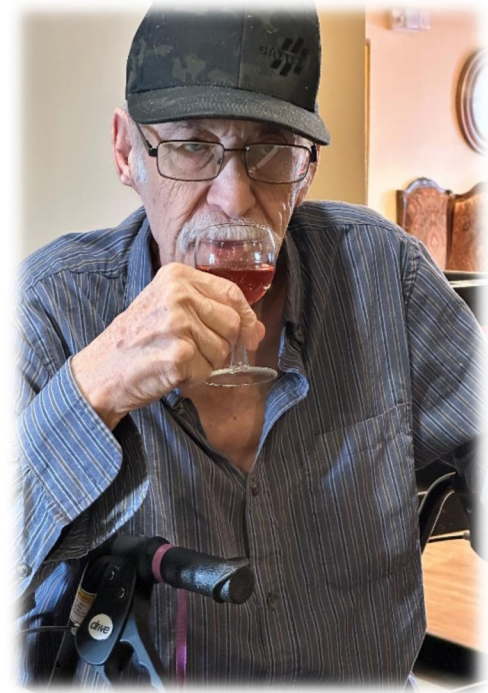


**Ronan Soriano, { PSW }**

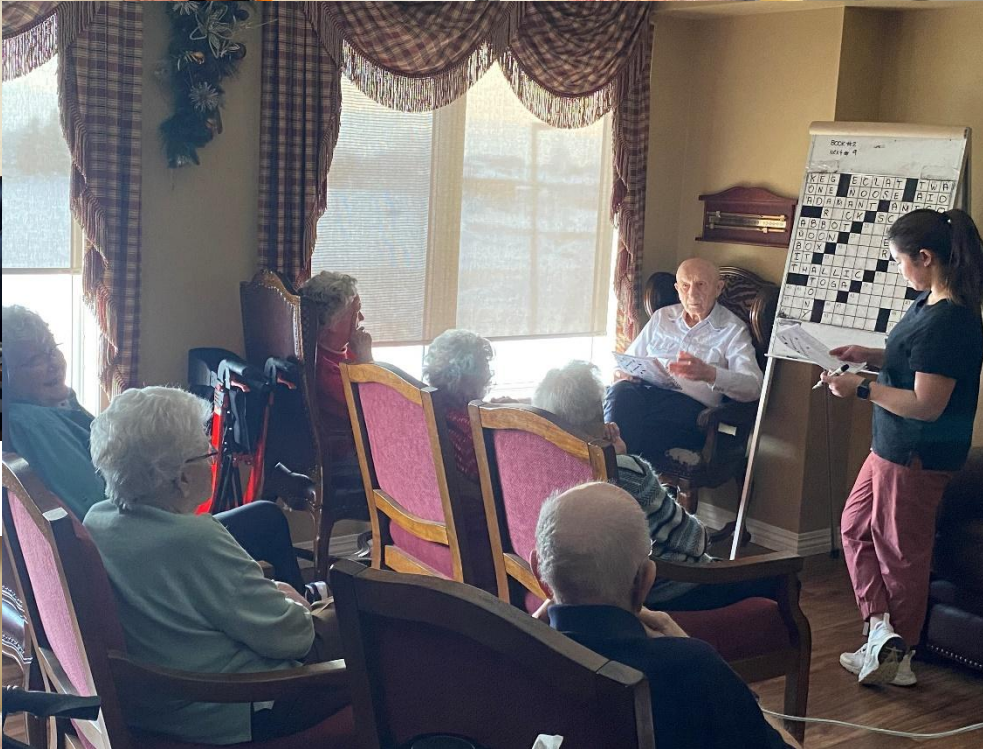
