Easter is a time of joy, feasting and love to all as we recall the steps God took to allow us all to approach and be reconciled with Him.

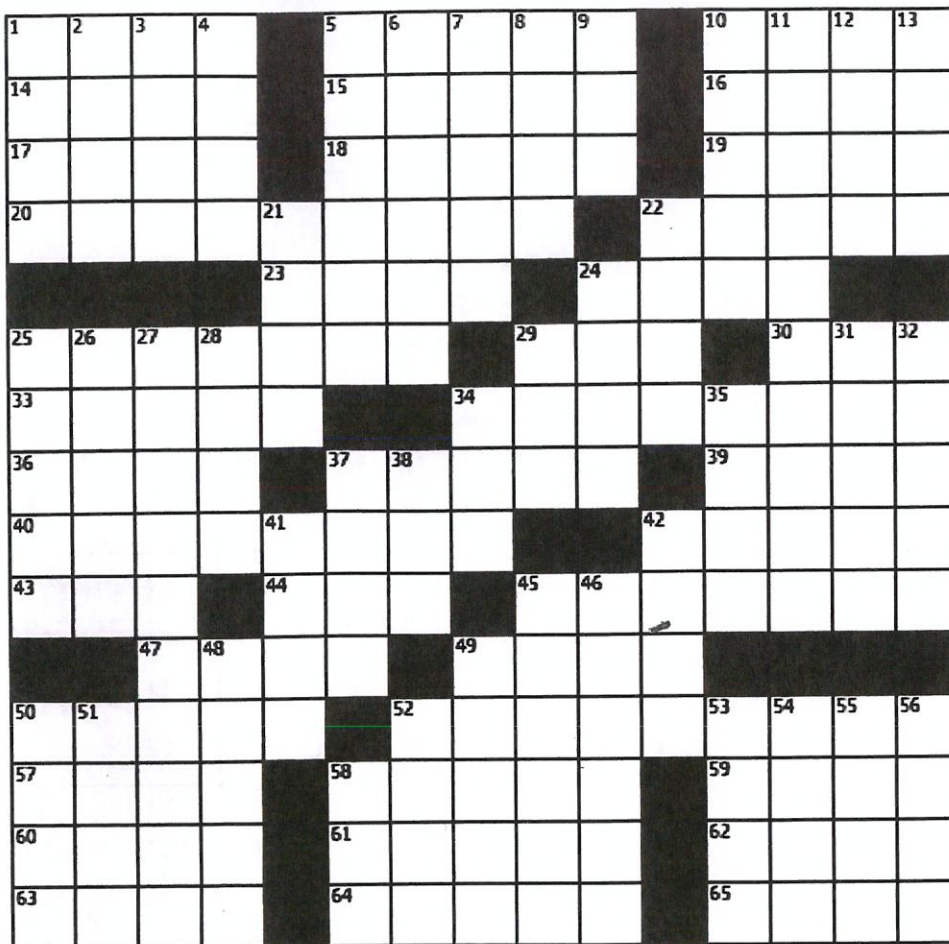
May your Easter, however you celebrate it, be one of rest, joy and hope for a brighter future.

"No sir, someone way more important"

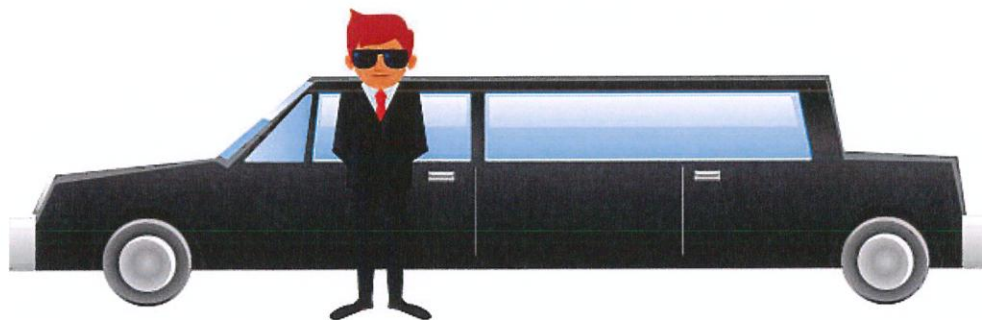
"Governor??? No sir, even more important!"

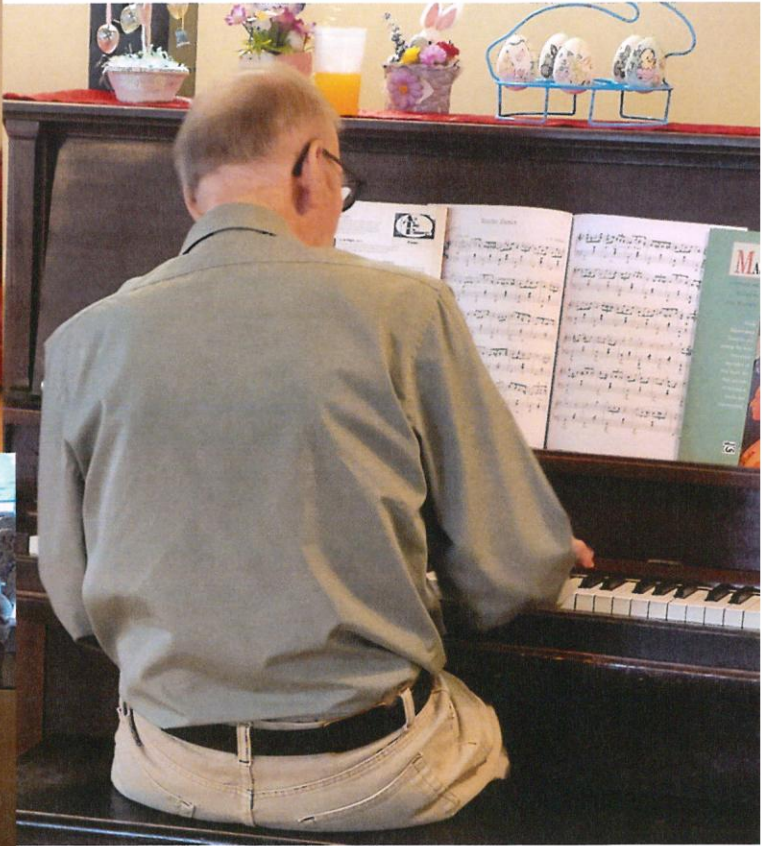
The Race was On.

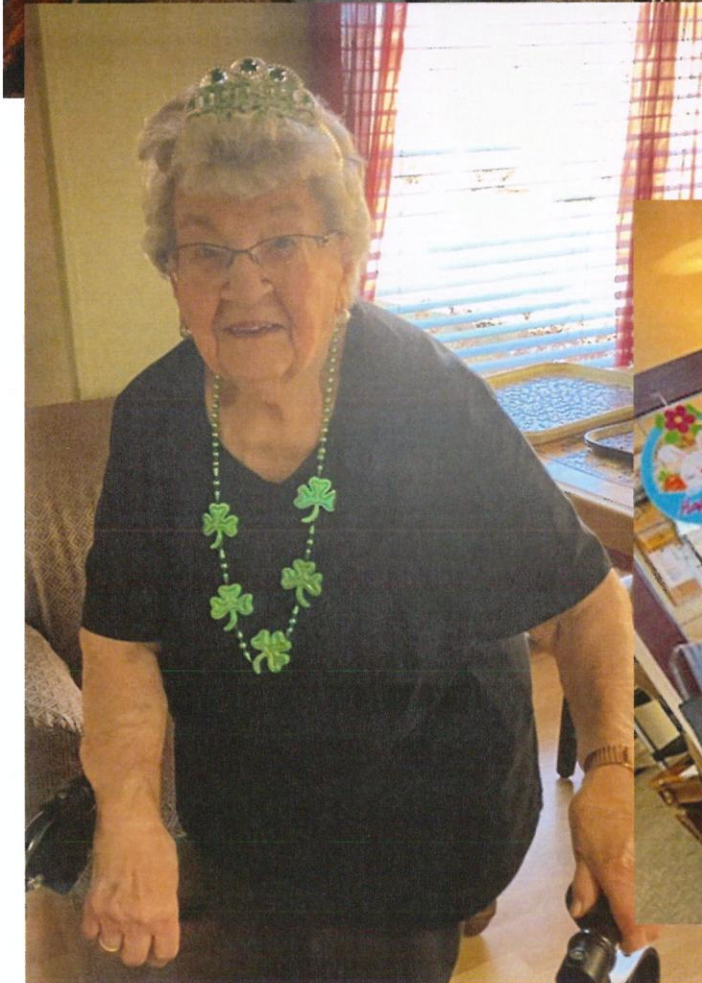

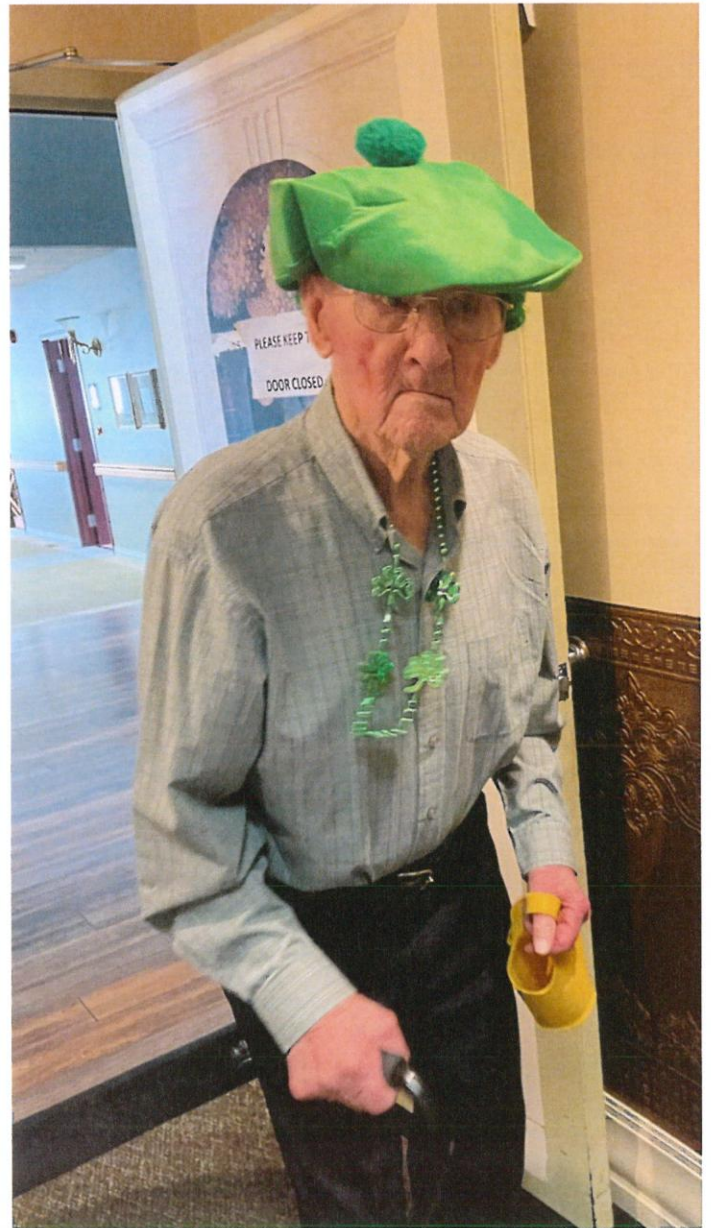
