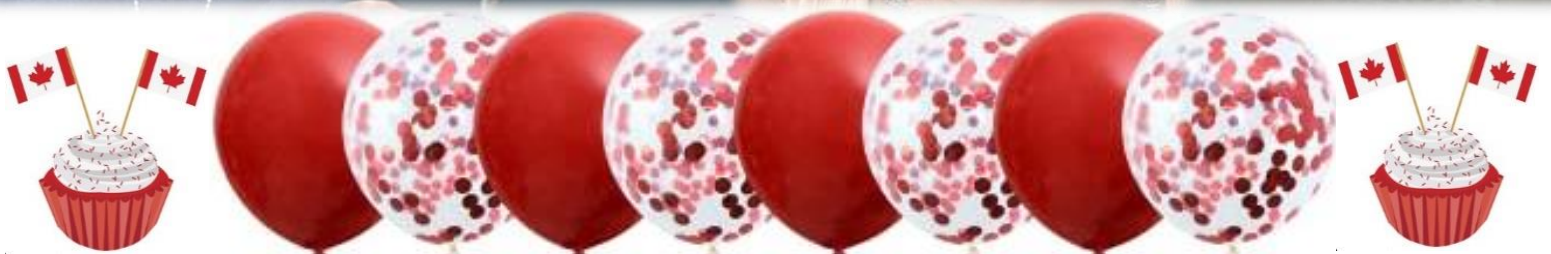

Alf will be remembered for his infectious smile and incredible sense of humor. He was always willing to lend a hand without hesitation. The family wishes to

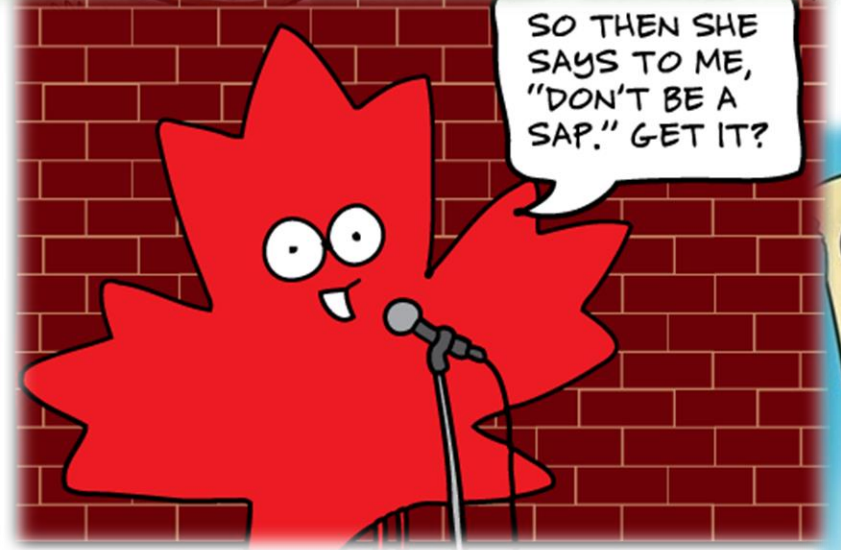
thank the staff at William Albert House for the excellent care and compassion he received while being a resident.

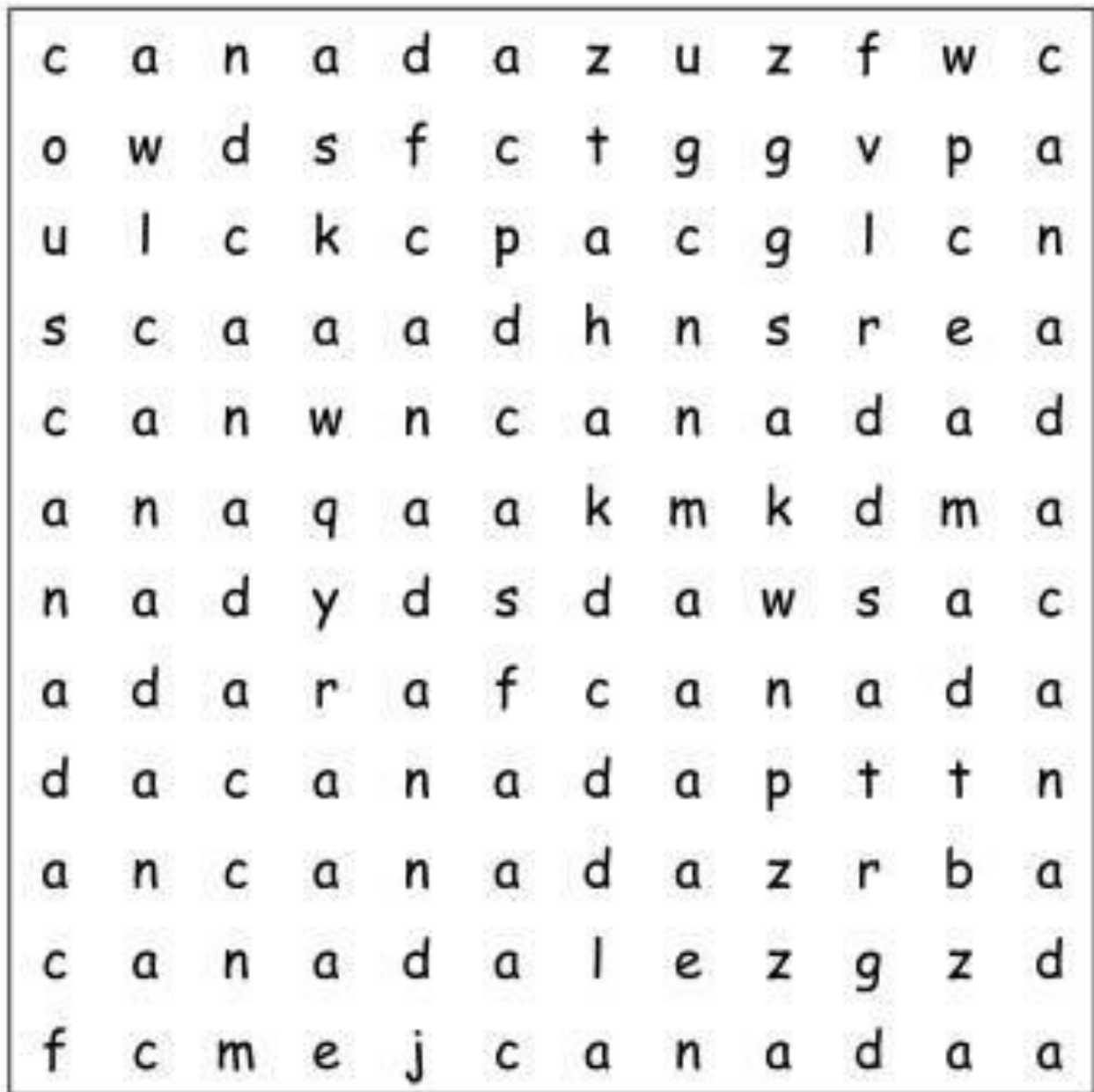
