

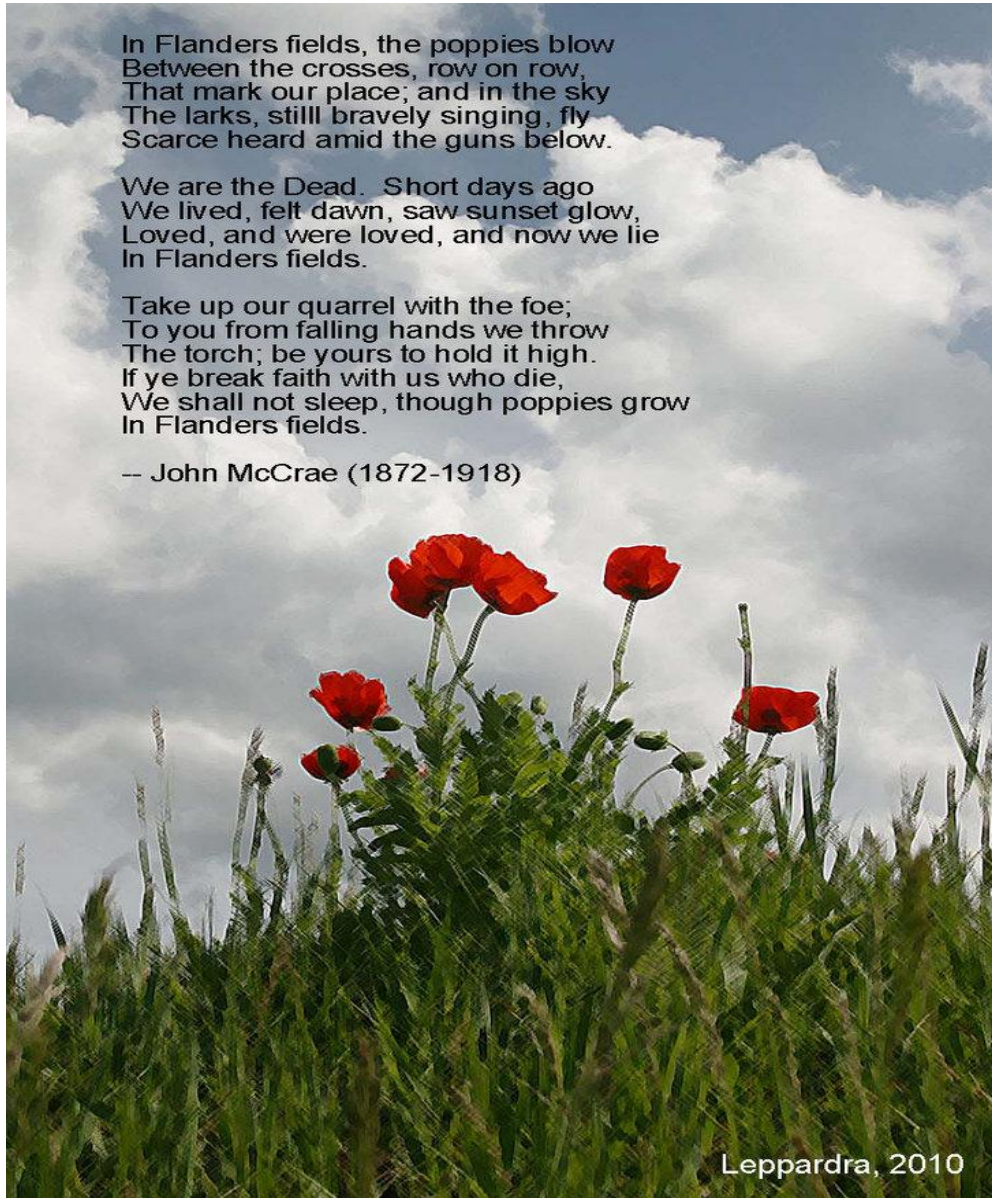
## November 2024 Newsletter
