Groundhog Day

Groundhog Day is a mystic day where hogs in the northern hemisphere may arise to predict the coming of spring. On <u>February 2nd</u>, at 8:00 each year since 1956, Canada's famous Groundhog, the Great Willie of Wiarton, emerges from hibernation in his burrow long enough to pronounce his weather report. Discovered in 1956, he has consistently delivered accurate predictions on the remaining course of winter, In fact, 90% of time his predictions have been correct! Last year, during the 138th and most recent prognostication event, the groundhog did not see its shadow, calling for an early spring for Canada.

Valentine's Day

Valentine's Day is an opportunity for people in Canada to tell somebody that they love them in a romantic way. It falls on February 14th, the name day of two saints, St. Valentine of Rome and St. Valentine of Terni. The origins of Valentine's Day are not clear. Around the year 1380, the English poet Chaucer wrote a poem for the first anniversary of the engagement of King Richard II to Anne of Bohemia. This is thought to be the first association between celebrations of romantic love and St. Valentine's Day on February 14th. The connection remained important throughout the middle ages. In the mid 19th century, there was an increase in interest in Valentine's Day, first in the United States, then in Canada. It was promoted by manufacturers of paper lace and cards as a means of increasing their sales. Gradually, this date was seen as an occasion for a man to present gifts to woman with whom he had or would like to have had a romantic relationship. It is also customary for lovers' to exchange handwritten notes. These have now largely been replaced by commercially produced cards. The most common symbols of Valentine's Day are heart shapes, which are used to decorate many things, including cards, trees, wrapping paper, cookies and gift boxes. Other symbols associated with February 14 are pairs of birds, cute teddy bears, Cupid and his arrows and couples kissing or embracing. The colors red and pink are often associated with Valentine's Day.



National Flag of Canada Day

The national flag of Canada was inaugurated on **February 15**, **1965**. The anniversary of this date is officially called the "National Flag of Canada Day", which is shortened to "Flag Day". The Royal Union Flag, which is also the flag of the United Kingdom, was used as the official flag of Canada until 1965. The National Flag of Canada's current design results from a period of discussion, debate and political maneuvering in the early 1960's.

George F.G. Stanley designed the current flag, which is inspired by the Royal Military College of Canada's flag. The multi-party parliamentary committee formed to select a new flag unanimously chose the design on October 29th, 1964. The House of Commons passed the design on December 15, 1964. Queen Elizabeth II proclaimed the new flag on January 28, 1965, and it was inaugurated on February 15 in the same year.





Family Day

Family Day is observed in the Canadian provinces of Ontario, Alberta and Saskatchewan on the third Monday of February – **February 17**th in 2025. This holiday celebrates the importance of families and family life to people in their communities.

Family Day was first held in Canada in the province of Alberta in 1990. It is supposed to reflect the values of family and home that were important to the pioneers who founded Alberta, and

give workers the opportunity to spend more time with their families. Family Day was

Introduced in Saskatchewan in 2007 and in Ontario in 2008. One of the reasons for introducing Family By Was that there was a long period when there were no holidays from New Year's Day until Good Friday.






We mourn the loss of resident, <u>Paulette Bert</u>, who passed away on December 25th, 2024.

Flag Do's And Don'ts

***Do** — The national Flag of Canada should always fly alone of its own mast or flagpole.



*DON'T — The dimensions/proportions of the National Flag

Canada have An exact ratio of 2 to1 (twice as long as it is wise), and must not be modified.

- *DO The National Flag of Canada can be flown at night without being lit.
- *DON'T- The National Flag of Canada should not be written on or marked in any way, nor be covered by other objects.
- *DO When the National Flag of Canada is raised or lowered, or when it is carried past in a parade or review, people should face the flag, men should remove their hats, and all should remain silent.
- *DON'T Nothing should be pinned or sewn on the National Flag of Canada.
- *DO Half-mast the National Flag of Canada should never be dipped or lowered to the ground as a means of paying a salute or compliment to any person or thing.

*DO — Replace a faded or torn flag with a new one. The correct form of disposing an old flag is by burning it in private.




