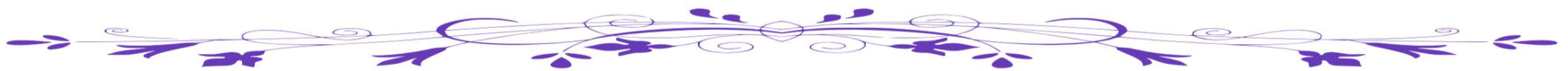

May their soul rest in peace in the arms of the Lord. Till we meet again.



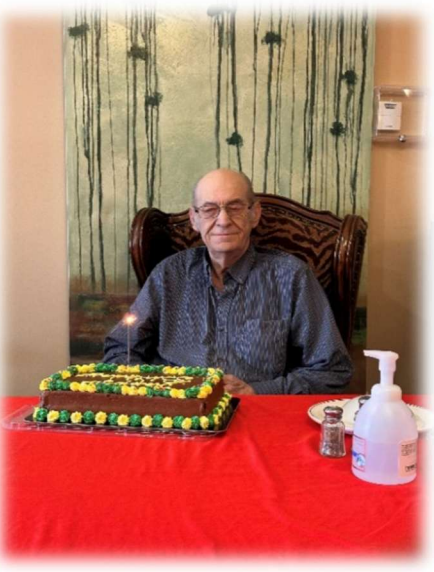
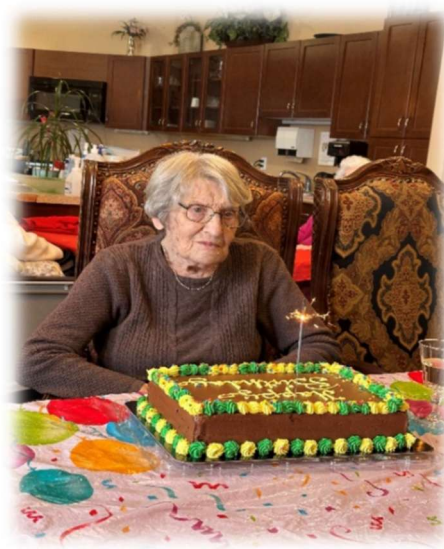
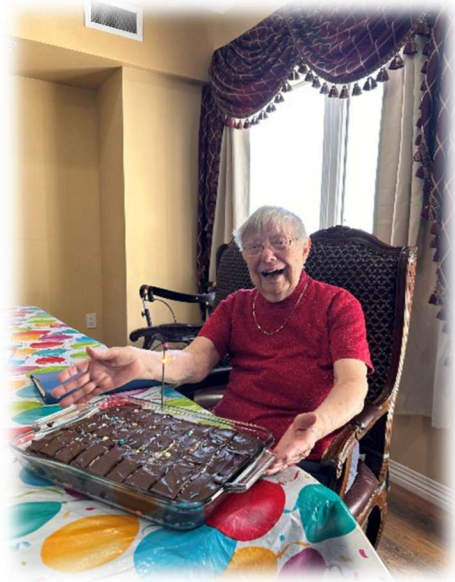
